

RULES FOR PARTICIPATION

“TAMMARO RURAL DESIGN WEEK” Morcone (BN), 27 April – 3 May 2026

Eligibility of Participants

The call is open to all individuals and groups of people, aged 18 or over, of any nationality.

Participation Rules and Deadlines

- To participate, applicants must duly complete **Annexes A and B** and submit them by email to rdw26@ruder.org no later than **28 February 2026**.
If the attachments exceed 20 MB, they may be sent via WeTransfer (or another large file-sharing platform) to the same email address: rdw26@ruder.org
- Requests for clarification regarding the call may be submitted until **21 February 2026**.
Notification of the selected works will be communicated by **16 March 2026**.
- Once authors have been notified of the selection of their works (**16 March 2026**), they will receive an invitation to submit their contribution by **6 April 2026**, in order to allow for exhibition setup. In the event of withdrawal, participants must notify the organization by **27 March 2026**.
- The costs of shipping the physical artwork and its installation will be covered by the organization. If physical shipping or on-site installation proves excessively costly, alternative exhibition methods will be agreed upon by the parties.
- A prize of **€1,500** (net of tax withholdings) will be awarded to the most deserving work in each of the three category.
- In addition, one of the selected works will receive a **special mention**, which includes the opportunity to conduct a **design residency in the Tammaro Valley/ Matese National Park** (by the end of June 2026). The residency includes: a prize of **€1,000** (net of tax withholdings), coverage of material costs, accommodation and access to a production space for the duration of the residency.
- All selected works will be exhibited to the public, in physical and/or printed/digital form, from **27 April to 3 May 2026 in Morcone (BN)**.
- Travel, accommodation, and subsistence expenses for the authors will be covered by the organizers **only** in the case of works awarded a prize or special mention. In the case of collective projects, expenses will be covered for **one representative member** of the group only.
- After **3 May 2026**, the artwork may be returned to the author at the author's own expense.
- Participants can apply to **all categories** of the call.
